OVERVIEW

This **year-long programme** provides an opportunity to extend your group-analytic thinking and practice, either as a stand-alone course or as part of further professional training in group analysis. This programme is open to individuals who have completed an approved Foundation Course in Group Analysis, and involves setting up and running a short-term group under supervision.

Throughout the course, you will undertake **weekly online study groups, experiential groups and supervision groups**, which will help you to build group-analytic 'muscle', equipping you to conduct groups in an institutional or agency setting.

Your progress in group analytic theory and practice will be assessed as part of the supervision, and through the successful completion of a written paper.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Terms One and Two (Autumn & Winter)

17:30 – 19:00: Online Study Group (90 minutes)

A facilitated group discussion of a topic related to the theory and practice of establishing and running group-analytic groups.

19:30 – 21:00: Online Experiential Group (90 minutes)

A group conducted by a qualified and experienced group analyst, aimed to help participants explore how the theory can be brought to life in a real group. These are not therapy groups, but participants often find them personally rewarding, challenging and insightful.

Term Three (Spring)

17:30 – 19:00: Online Median Group (90 minutes)

In the median group, the two small experiential groups come together to explore how it impacts dynamics when two established 'communities' combine.

19:30 – 21:00: Online Experiential Group (continued from terms one and two)

Terms one, two and three:

Each term will have a one-off in-person workshop and median group on a Saturday or Sunday (09:30 – 15:00). Places on these days will also be open to trainees on the GASW Foundation Course, and to members of the public as a stand-alone CPD event.
